

Squash Club Championships 2018

Rules & Guidelines

- You must be a member to participate. If you aren't a full member and playing out of your booking parameters you will need to pay a guest fee.
- Draws and rules are posted on board in the main foyer upstairs and on-line at www.vrc.bc.ca
- No courts have been assigned except for all the final matches (Main draws) May 15th, 16th & 17th for Doubles and May 17th for Singles.
- **A Sunday date for each round has been assigned for the completion of that round. Please adhere to this date so as the next round will be on time. Please get a hold of your opponents early and play your match by that date.**
- Please check to see all consolation matches are recorded. All matches with a C# means the loser goes to the consolation. Please check it corresponds to the correct C#
- All matches are considered ladder matches so they can be recorded to the Club Ladder. Winner's responsibility.
- Scoring for Men is Par 11 (win by 2 at 10 all)
- Scoring for Women is Par 15 (win by 2 at 14 all).
- Any scoring system may be used if both players agree.
- Scoring for Doubles is Par 15 – No set (First to 15)
- Winners enter scores, Main & Consolation on the draw posted in the lounge. Make sure the player going to consolation draw matches the consolation number, i.e. if it is C7, mark the player in C7. Draws on line will also be updated weekly
- Balls are not supplied.
- To be eligible for the membership draw:
 - o You must be a current 2018-19 member and entry fee must be paid prior to the draw.
 - o Must be present when the draw takes place (May 17th, approximately at 9:30pm after the finals)
- Gift certificates will be awarded to the Winners, Runner-ups, and Consolation Winners if you are a member in good standing.
